THE IMPORTANCE OF BILINGUAL DICTIONARIES

The definition of a word is from Spanish to English or from English to Spanish in a bilingual dictionary. A bilingual dictionary gives people the definitions they need to know. So it is easy to translate and to understand different kinds of readings.

People can find bilingual dictionaries in the bookstores or libraries. Sometimes they include technical words, for example, in computing. But if they are looking for synonyms, they need a monolingual (using only one language) dictionary.

It is very important to use a dictionary, if students sit to study English at school, at home or at the library. They can ask for help to the teacher when they do not understand the definition.
