Past tense of the verb “to be”

1. Completa con la conjugación correcta del verbo “to be” en pasado simple (afirmativo).

a) Mark **was** at school yesterday.

Explicación: Singular en pasado to be: was.

Mark fue a la escuela ayer.

b) Lissa **was** there.

Explicación: Singular pasado to be.

Lissa estaba ahí.

c) We **were** happy.

Explicación: pasado to be plural.

Nosotros estábamos felices.

d) Tom and Carl **were** good friends.

Explicación: plural verbo to be.

Tom y Carl eran buenos amigos.

e) The concert **was** amazing.

Explicación: Con “it” se utiliza was, pasado singular del verbo to be

El concierto estuvo asombroso.

f) You **were** right.

Explicación: “You” utiliza el plural en pasado del verbo to be.

Tú estabas en lo correcto.

2. Completa:

Usaremos WAS con los pronombres **she**, **he**, **it**, **I**; mientras que WERE lo asociaremos con **we**, **they** y **you**.

Explicación:

Pronombres: WAS:she (ella), he (él), it (eso), I (yo).

WERE: we (nosotros/nosotras), they (ellas/ellos), you (usted).

3. Escribe 10 oraciones en pasado simple. 5 en afirmativo y 5 en negativo.

Explicación: Pasado simple se utiliza was/were con los pronombres mencionados anteriormente.

Afirmativo:

1. The game was amazing.

2. She was a great mother.
3. We were at the school.
4. I was very happy when i was a child.
5. He was in my house yesterday.

Negativo:

1. They weren't good friends.
2. He wasn't my boyfriend.
3. I wasn't with her last week.
4. We weren't at university.
5. She wasn't mad at me.
