

#### How does the Verb BE + adjective work?


Take a look at the following sentence

#### How does the Verb BE + adjective work?

With an adjective, we frequently use TO BE.

The form is:

Subject + To be + adjective


• Daniel is old.




The negative form is:

Subject + To be + not + adjective


• Daniel is not old.


