

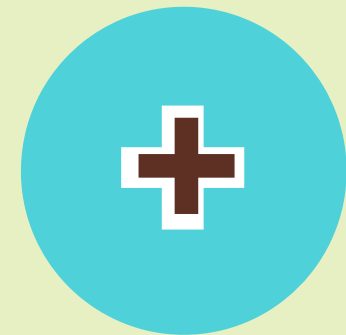

How does the Verb BE + adjective work?

Take a look at the following sentence

Daniel is old



An adjective is a word that gives us a description about something or someone
Old is an adjective. **Old** is a description of Daniel.



How does the Verb BE + adjective work?

Take a look at the following sentence

With an adjective, we frequently use TO BE.

The form is:

Subject + To be + adjective

- Daniel is old.



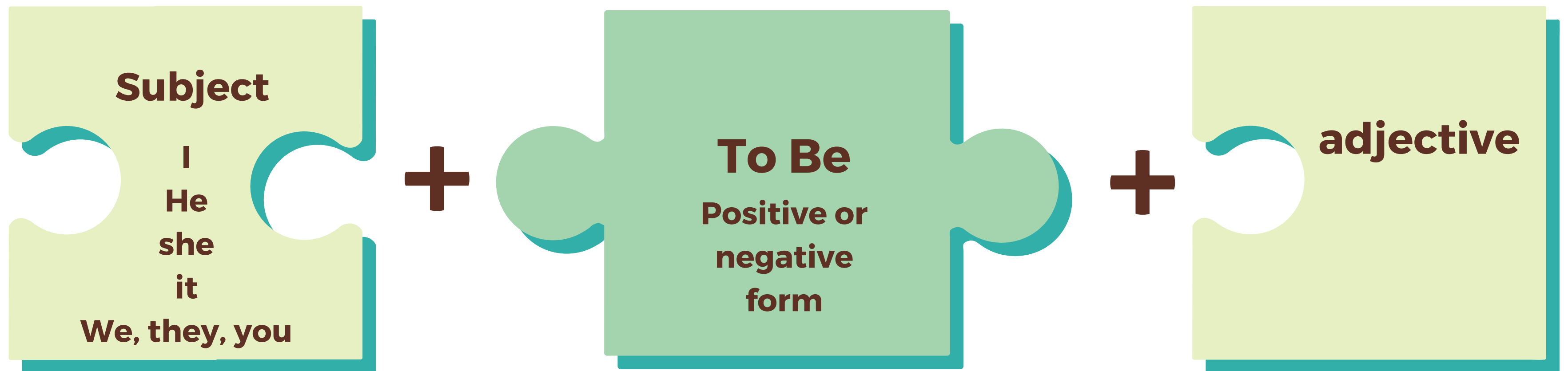
The negative form is:

Subject + To be + not + adjective

- Daniel is not old.



How does Verb BE + adjective work?

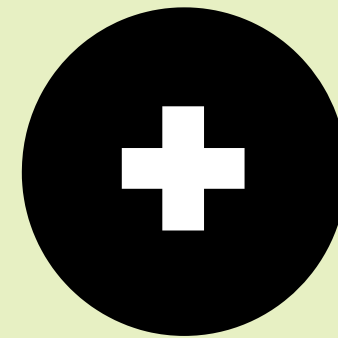
