

TOOLS FOR USING THE INTERNET

There are different tools available for using the Internet. Each performs certain tasks. The tools you are most likely to encounter include the following:

- Email clients: They allow you to send and receive electronic mail
 messages. To check your email on the Internet, you must first have access to
 the Internet and an email account set up that provides you with an email
 address.
- Telnet software: It allows you to log into another computer system and use that system's resources just as if they were your own.
- Listserv software: It allows you to set up discussion groups or mailing lists on any subject of interest. Others subscribe to these groups if they are interested in the topic. Messages are sent to the listserv address and routed to the subscribers to read, ignore, delete or respond.
- FTP (File transfer protocol): This software allows you to retrieve files from publicly accessible areas of other computers (called anonymous FTP access). Archives of information allow users to search for and discover particular files that are available through FTP sites.
- Gopher software: It connects you to Gopher servers. They form a loose system of menu-driven information resources located all over the Internet.

All these tools will surely help you manage the use of the Internet better, and it will help you save time with your tasks.

SNAPCHAT

Young people are immersed in digital images, and Snapchat feeds an attention economy that draws people into noticing, engaging and responding. With approximately seven billion video clip views each day, Snapchat has become powerful.



Young people are becoming experts in multimedia production, as they post the photographs and videos that narrate their lives. They

are skillful at using the range of filters provided by the application that enable them to manipulate their media. These can be like carnival mirrors that distort faces, add exaggerated or cartoon lips, among other effects. Users can even exchange faces with friends, or merge them with images stored on their phone, or blend them on the spot in a group selfie.

Emojis represent another new form of digital expression. They are small cartoon images



stored in the app and applied to symbolize mood or make jokes. These can be enlarged in proportion with the image and moved around to enhance the original, so a happy or sad face can be used to replace a real face.

This app also extends to the rich and famous. Celebrities use Snapchat to broadcast the details of their lives and get the public's attention. They solicit approval, enabling audiences to get to know the "real" them.

A SUCCESSFUL BUSINESSMAN

William Henry Gates III, better known as Bill Gates, is one of the world's richest people and perhaps the most successful businessman ever. He co-founded the software giant Microsoft and turned it into the world's largest software company. He is the best-known entrepreneur of the personal computer revolution (PC revolution). He has also written two best-selling books and started his own charity with his wife.

Gates was fascinated with electronics from a young age. In 1975, he read about a small technology company. He contacted them to see if they were interested in a computer program he had written. This led to the creation of Microsoft. Gates later struck a deal with the International Business Machines Corporation (IBM) that put Microsoft Windows on IBM computers. This deal made Microsoft a major player in the information technology industry.

Gates was in charge at Microsoft from 1975 until 2006. He was an active software developer at the beginning. He had a vision that computers could change everyone's life. He helped make this vision come true and developed many products that are now part of modern life. His management style has been studied and copied around the world.

Gates stepped down as Microsoft CEO in June 2008. He now spends his time with his wife, Melinda, focusing on their charitable foundation, something they call their personal project. They provide funds towards global problems that are ignored by governments and other organizations. Time magazine voted Gates as one of the biggest influences of the 20th Century.
