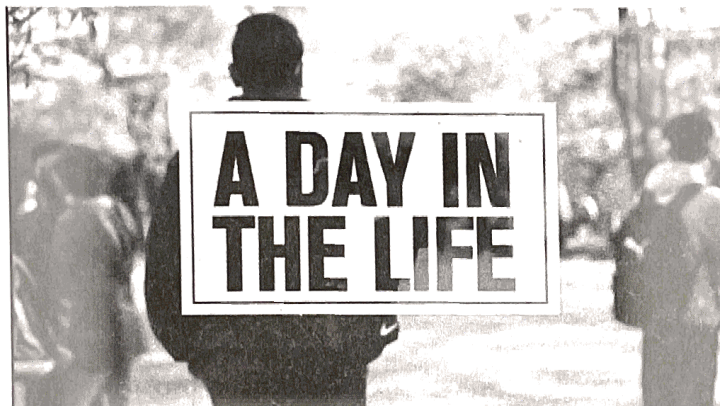

Players wear gloves, specially designed to catch the ball.

If successful, the batter runs towards the first base, then the second, third, and finally back to the home plate. This run is called a 'home run'. However, the opposing team's players try to catch the ball and tag the runner out before he completes the run. The team that scores the most runs wins the game.

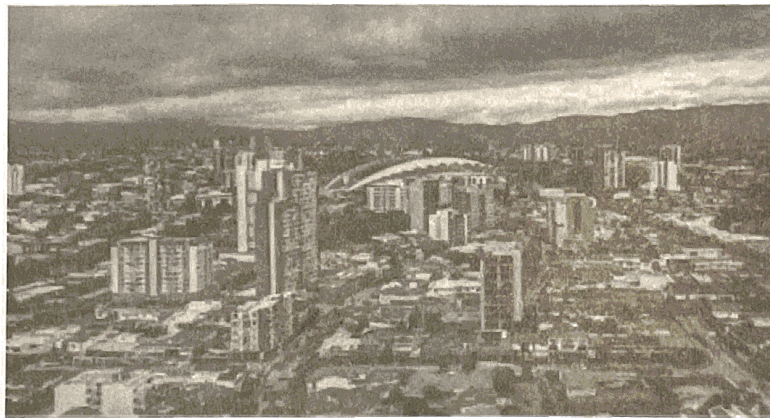
WHERE IS IT?

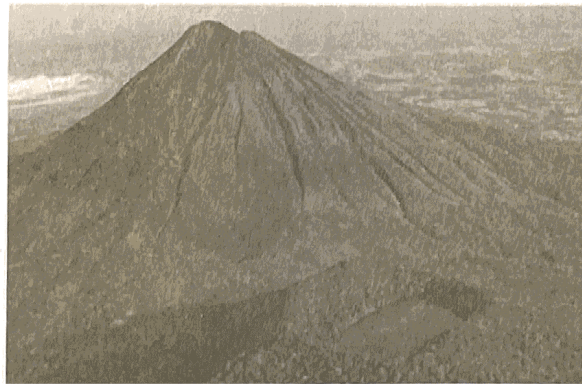
AN INCIDENT I WILL ALWAYS REMEMBER

BEAUTIFUL COSTA RICA

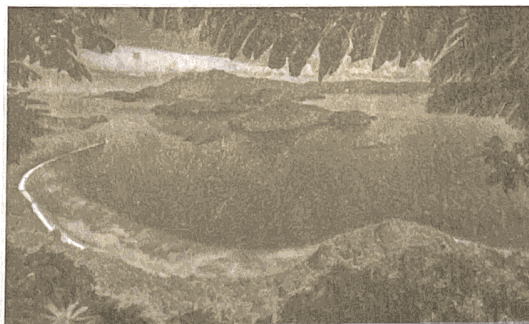
