## VOLUNTEER IN COSTA RICA

Kim: The coffee project is Ego agriculture so that means you are working with all sorts of planting, the farmers up here, have some of the most various farms I've ever seen, from fruits, and veggies and then of course, you're working with the coffee too. Depending on the time of year, picking berries, peeling, from the berries to the cup, there are about fifty different steps, so every day, it's something different. The project is in San Luis so it's outside the city. Monteverde is the best for extra circular activities, you can do waterfall hikes, or just hiking in general. Night hikes, butterfly gardens, there's so much nature and a tour for it.



Rob: The project started to try and protect this population of turtles here before they became extinct. Local people in this community continuously stole the eggs from the beach, poaching them for about forty years, so they did a good job of removing every nest from the beach during that time. The volunteers will have the right kind of hands-on experiences, so they'll get to pick up the eggs, and they'll get to take the eggs out of the nest when the turtles are there, and to pick up the turtles as well, check for damage and that kind of things, and to help us record all those scientific data that we take at the time when she's nesting. Then we'll carry the eggs over to the hatchery (a place for growing or development of something) helping us to relocate them in the hatchery where they're being incubated for about two months.

David: The turtles come out at night so if you see a nesting turtle, you have to put a label in it if it's not already labeled, you can pick the eggs out while the turtles are laying them, and you put them in a bag, you transport them in the hatchery, where you find a nest in there, there's a hundred and twelve spots, you camouflage it, cause their poachers on the beach. My advice for future volunteers is that don't have second thoughts just do it, come down here, have an open mind, and prepare to immerse yourself as much as you can.

Betty: I think when I leave, I am going to miss the people here, the community, and the experience of, like staying at home, learning Spanish, and the turtles.

Ashly: I love being immersed in this culture, I just love absorbing the different customs and I'll miss the home feeling of Costa Rica. I've kind of fallen in love with this country. So, I've been thinking of switching to medical, but I can't, I can't leave, I know I won't be able to leave because I am so attached to the kids now. Costa Rica is beautiful, so we've been trying to take advantage of seeing as many awesome things as we can.
